

Day 1: Departure

You will be amazed by the Acropolis and the view of the ancient Corinthian valley below. On our way back to Athens, we will visit the Port of Kehreas, where Paul sailed for Ephesus. Lunch on your own at a local restaurant.

Day 4: Athens & the Majestic Princess

After a good night's rest, we begin our day with a tour of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis, the Parthenon, and Erectheum before viewing Athens from atop Mars Hill where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers. Then we're off to the port of Piraeus to embark on the Maiestic Princess cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful **Cruise Ship: Majestic Princess**

Day 5: Mykonos

Our first stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos Windmills. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own.

Day 6: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 7: Cyprus

We will arrive early at Limassol, Cyprus for a six-hour bus tour. Our excursion will take us along the coastal route to the ancient city-kingdom of Curium with its well-preserved mosaics, theatre, and basilica. We will visit the mythological birthplace of Aphrodite and then visit Pafos to view the mosaics in the house of Dionysos. Next, we will visit St. Paul's Pillar, where it is believed that Paul was whipped by the Romans. We will stop at Yeroskipou on our way back to the ship and tour St. Paraskevi, a bascilla surmounted by five domes which form a cross and has exquisite 15th century mural paintings.

Day 8: Jerusalem

We will arrive at the port of Ashdod, Israel and travel to Jerusalem for a fullday tour of the Holy City. After an inspiring devotional on the Mount of Olives, we walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane. How many have wished to be whisked back in time to catch a glimpse of our Lord or hear His voice if only for a moment? To walk between the ancient olive trees, read the Scriptures of Jesus' prayer and take time for personal reflection is important here.

We will continue our sightseeing just outside the Dung Gate on the southeastern hill below the Temple Mount in the City of David. It was during the time of Solomon that the city limits extended past this part of Jerusalem. We will visit the Gihon Springs, the original water source for Jerusalem, view new excavations including a typical Israelite four-room house, and the lower city wall. A highlight will be an optional water walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel to the pool of Siloam, the



For those who opted for the Rome Extension, we will begin our tour of Rome with a visit to the Catacombs, where thousands of Christians were buried in a remarkable tiered series of galleries. Next, we will visit the Coliseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. The Coliseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Coliseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. Hear the stories of the games that have fascinated people for hundreds of vears. We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by

Titus in AD 70. We will then tour the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

Day 2: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abby of the Three Fountains, Palatine Hill & St. Peter's Square

We will begin our second day in Rome with a downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Then we will visit the Abby of the Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for his faith and

the ancient roads that he walked on. We will then continue to the Palatine Hill which is an open-air museum that housed imperial palaces and the nucleus of the Roman Empire. Next, we visit St. Peter's Square with an optional visit to the Vatican and Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own.
