After a good night's rest, we begin our day with a tour of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis, the Parthenon, and Erectheum before viewing Athens from

atop Mars Hill. From here we hear a devotional from Acts where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers.

Our first stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos Windmills. ### Day 6: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship as you spend a day at sea.

### Day 7: Cyprus

We will arrive early at Limassol, Cyprus for a six-hour bus tour. Our excursion will take us along the coastal route to the ancient city-kingdom of Curium with its well-preserved mosaics, theatre, and basilica. ship and tour St. Paaskevi, a bascilla surmounted by five domes which form a cross and has exquisite 15th century mural paintings.

The island of Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. We will enjoy a walking tour of Lindos, a fortress used by the Greeks and Phoenicians, followed by a visit to the great palace and acropolis of the Grand Masters of Knight.

#### Day 9: Santorini

Today we stop at one of the most beautiful islands in the world. It's on the bucket list of many! Explore on your own or join a Princess excursion. It is a very accessible city and a beautiful place to explore on your own. The ship does not dock at a port here, instead we will disembark onto "tenders," the small boats from the ship that will take us to the island. Those with limited mobility will need to be extra careful or possibly stay onboard.

#### Day 10: Kusadasi (for Ephesus)

Today you visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where St. Paul preached and taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people. See Marble Street, the Library of Celsius, and the Temple of Hadrian. You will also see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the site of the scene of religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts. St. Paul had founded the Church here and was used of God to bring a major revival.





#### Day 11: Crete

Arrive in Heraklion, Crete. You will have time to explore on your own with an optional cruise excursion or enjoy the day walking on this beautiful Greek island, known for its famous archeological sites (Knossos and Phaistos Palaces), stunning beaches, and lively town which is full of hidden treasures from the Venetian period.

Next, we will visit the Coliseum where thousands of people. animals, and Christians pershed. The Coliseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Coliseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. Hear the stories of the games that have fascinated people for hundreds of years.

We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70.

Titus in AD 70. We will then tour the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

## Day 2: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abby of the Three Fountains, Palatine Hill & St. Peter's Square

We will begin our second day in Rome with a downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Then we will visit the Abby of the Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for his faith and

the ancient roads that he walked on. We will then continue to the Palatine Hill which is an open-air museum that housed imperial palaces and the nucleus of the Roman Empire. Next, we visit St. Peter's Square with an optional visit to the Vatican and Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own.
