FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL

Cruise/Tour + Optional 3-Day Rome Extension

June 17-30 or July 2, 2025

Day 1: Departure

Overnight flight departing international airport near you. (Flight arrangements made on your own or by Rishon Tours.)

Day 2: Arrive in Athens

Arrive at the Athens Airport. Transfer to our hotel where we will spend the next two nights. If time permits, we will take a bus tour of Athens and enjoy a beautiful view of the city. Breakfast and dinners in Athens are included at the hotel, lunches are on your own.

Day 3: Corinth & Port of Kehreas

We will begin our day with a bus tour to Corinth. Along the way we will stop at the Corinth Canal and then continue our journey to Corinth, one of ancient Greece's most important port cities. We will tour the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, the Roman Odeon along with the Bema and Gallio's Seat where Paul stood trial before the Roman proconsul, Gallio. You will be amazed by the Acropolis and the view of the ancient Corinthian valley below. On our way back to Athens, we will visit the Port of Kehreas, where Paul sailed for Ephesus. Lunch on your own at a local restaurant.

Day 4: Athens & the Majestic Princess

After a good night's rest, we begin our day with a tour of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis, the Parthenon, and Erechtheum before viewing Athens from atop Mars Hill where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers. Then we're off to the port of Piraeus to embark on the Majestic Princess cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful cruise ship.

Cruise Ship: Majestic Princess

Day 5: Mykonos

Our first stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos Windmills. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own.

Day 6: Kusadasi (for Ephesus)

Today you visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where St. Paul preached and taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people. See Marble Street, the Library of Celsius, and the Temple of Hadrian. You will also see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the site of the scene of religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts. St. Paul had founded the Church here and was used of God to bring a major revival.

Day 7: Rhodes

The island of Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. We will enjoy a walking tour of Lindos, a fortress used by the Greeks and Phoenicians, followed by a visit to the great palace and acropolis of the Grand Masters of Knight.

Day 8: Crete

Enjoy charming Chania (Souda), Crete on your own. Chania provides narrow streets lined with local shops and restaurants. Visit the Archeological Museum, home to artifacts from Neolithic to Roman times. Or enjoy the picture-perfect waters of Fallasarna, a beach surrounded by olive groves.

Day 9: Katakolon (Olympia)

This small port on the Ionian coast is your gateway to ancient Olympia, the home of the original Olympic Games. Most intriguing is the stadium, which is still standing, and the gymnasium. The museum also offers a peek at fabulous Greek sculptures. This Grecian port city is also the gateway to one of the most important archeological sites in the world, the ruins of ancient Olympia. As the birthplace of the Olympics, the great stadium still echoes the cheering of the first superstars of the sport. Soak up the gorgeous Katakolon waterfront views while savoring traditional Greek specialties. And of course, an abundance of calamari and other fresh seafood brought in by local fishermen are always on menus. Explore on your own or join a Princess excursion.

Day 10: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together again for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, enjoy the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 11: Malta

We arrive on the Island of Malta where Paul was shipwrecked. Paul and the others spent 3 months on this island before being transported to Rome for trial (Acts 28:1, 11). We will visit St. Thomas Bay, which many scholars believe is the actual site of Paul's shipwreck. From the shore you can see the reef described in Acts 28. We will visit the Malta Maritime Museum and see the Roman Anchors which were found by divers at the exact depth described in the book of Acts. We will also have time to explore on our own before embarking again on our cruise ship.

Day 12: Day at Sea

We will come together again for a time of worship and teaching from the book of Acts before enjoying another day at sea.

Day 13: Naples

You will have time to explore on your own southern Italy's largest city, Naples. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own.

Day 14: Rome—Depart for Home or Optional Rome Extension

We will have an early morning arrival at the cruise terminal in Rome. Those who did not select the Rome Extension option will transfer to the airport and depart for the U.S.

Optional Rome Extension

Day 1: Catacombs, Coliseum, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, & the Mamertine Prison

For those who opted for the Rome Extension, we will begin our tour of Rome with a visit to the Catacombs, where thousands of Christians were buried in a remarkable tiered series of galleries. Next, we will visit the Coliseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. The Coliseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Coliseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. Hear the stories of the games that have fascinated people for hundreds of years. We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70. We will then tour the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

Day 2: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abby of the Three Fountains, Palatine Hill & St. Peter's Square

We will begin our second day in Rome with a downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Then we will visit the Abby of the Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for his faith and the ancient roads that he walked on. We will then continue to the Palatine Hill which is an open-air museum

that housed imperial palaces and the nucleus of the Roman Empire. Next, we visit St. Peter's Square with an optional visit to the Vatican and Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own.

Day 3: Depart for Home

We will transfer to the airport in the morning to depart for the U.S. and enjoy the memories of a trip of a lifetime!
