

Day 1: Departure

Day 2: Arrive in Rome

Welcome to Rome, Italy! Before we are transported to our hotel, we will tour the ancient Catacombs, where thousands of Christians were buried. Next, we will visit St. Peter's Square for an optional tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own. Afterwards, we will enjoy a pleasant evening at our hotel and get a good night's rest so that we are ready to start touring this ancient, beautiful city the next morn-

Day 3: Colosseum, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, Palatine Hill & the **Mamertine Prison**

We will begin our day with a visit the Colosseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. The Colosseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Colosseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. Hear the stories of the games that have fascinated people for hundreds of years. We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70.

We will then tour the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

Day 4: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abbey of Three Fountains

We will begin our third day in Rome with a downtown walking four that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Then we will visit the Abbey of Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for his faith and the ancient roads that he walked on.

We will transfer to the airport in the evening to depart for Athens, the foundation of democracy.

Day 5: Athens & the Celebrity In-

After a good night's rest, we will begin our day with a funicular ride up Mount Lycabbetus for a breathtaking view of the city from the highest point in central Athens.

Then we're off to the port of Piraeus to embark on the Celebrity Infinity cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful cruise ship.

Day 6: Santorini

Today we stop at one of the most beautiful islands in the world. It's on the bucket list of many! Explore on your own or join a Celebrity excursion. It is a very accessible city and a beautiful place to explore on your own. The ship does not dock at a port here, instead we will disembark onto "tenders," the small boats from the ship that will take us to the island. Those with limited mobility will need to be extra careful or possibly stay onboard.

Day 7: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together again for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, enjoy the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 8: Kusadasi (for Ephesus)

Today you visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where St. Paul preached and taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people. See Marble Street, the Library of Celsius, and the Temple of Hadrian. You will also see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the site of the scene of religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts. St. Paul had founded the Church here and was used of God to bring a maior revival.

Day 9: Mykonos

Our next stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos Windmills. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own.

Day 10: Volos

Volos, Greece's newest port city, is located at the foot of Mount Pelion and the innermost point of the Pagasetic Gulf. As an important industrial center and bridge between Europe and Asia, this lively seafront destination offers you many things to discover—local cultural activities, museums, cafes, and restaurants. Tucked into the northeastern coast of Greece, the hillside city of Kavala (ancient city of Philippi) overlooks the Aegean Sea and is the main seaport of eastern Macedonia.
