### Day 1: Departure

Overnight flight from an international airport near you. (Flight arrangements made on your own or by Rishon Tours.)

Upon arriving in Athens, we will take a bus tour of the city from the Athens Airport to our hotel in Corinth. We will stop at the Corinth Canal for some pictures and to learn about the history of this famous canal. Breakfast and dinner in Corinth are included at the hotel, lunches are on your own.

### Day 3: Corinth & Holland America's Oosterdam

We wake up this morning in Corinth! We begin with a tour of the ancient biblical city, one of ancient Greece's most important and thriving port cities. Paul spent much time in Corinth and his story comes to life when you stand at the very place where Paul stood trial for preaching the gospel.

Then we're off to the port of Piraeus in Athens to embark on *Holland America's Oosterdam* cruise ship and continue our Lands of the Bible journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful cruise ship.

### Day 4: Day at Sea

Days at sea give an opportunity to gather as a group for worship and teaching from the Bible as we prepare for the journey ahead. The rest of the day, relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship and visiting with friends as you spend a day at sea.

### Day 5: Alexandria, Egypt (Cairo)

Today we arrive in Alexandria, Egypt, and travel three-hours by bus to Cairo. During our guided tour to Cairo, we will learn about Egypt's history and be reminded of God's plan to deliver His people from slavery through His servant, Moses. Once we arrive in Cairo, you will have free time to behold the iconic pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx, and tour the famous Antiquities Museum to admire the amazing treasures of King Tut. You will also have time to shop and enjoy lunch on your own before we board the bus and return to our ship in time for a delicious dinner.

### Day 6: Day at Sea

Today is a day at sea. We gather again on the ship for worship and teaching from the Bible as we prepare for our time in Israel. Afterward, relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship and visiting with friends as you spend a day at sea.

### Day 7: Jerusalem, Israel

This morning our ship docks Haifa, Israel and brings us to the Holy City of Jerusalem. We begin at the Mount of Olives where we overlook Jerusalem and the Temple Mount. We will hear a devotional teaching about Jesus' Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem. Then we will walk to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed to the Father the night He was betrayed and arrested. Afterward, we visit the Western Wall, known as the Wailing Wall, followed by a fascinating tour of the City of David and an optional walk through Hezekiah's water tunnel and hear a devotional teaching at the Pool of Siloam. We will close our day at the Garden Tomb where it is believed Jesus Christ was crucified at Golgotha and buried nearby and rose victoriously three days later. There we will worship and partake of communion together.

### Day 8: Galilee, Israel

Our second day in Israel begins with a devotional at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave His inspiring Sermon on the Mount. Next, we tour Capernaum where Jesus did many of His miracles, and the home of the Apostle Peter. We will also tour the Fishing Boat Museum and enjoy an included St. Peter's fish for lunch. We end our day with a relaxing wooden boat cruise on the Sea of Galilee and reflect on the miracles which confirmed Jesus is God the Son.

### Day 9: Cyprus

We will arrive early at Limassol, Cyprus for a six-hour tour. Barnabas and Paul spent much time on Cyprus during their first missionary journey and brought the Gospel to many in Cyprus. Our excursion will take us along the coastal route to include the Castle of Kolossi, built to support those making pilgrimage to the Holy Lands. We then visit the ancient city-kingdom of Curium with its well-preserved mosaics, theatre, and basilica. Afterward, we visit Paphos and the site where Paul received 39 lashes for preaching the Gospel. At the port Paphos you will have time to stroll through the marina and enjoy lunch on your own before returning to the ship.

### Day 10: Antalya, Turkey

Paul and Barnabas visited this city on their first missionary journey. Antalya was a gateway to Asia Minor and the cities of Paul's first missionary journey in Asia Minor. Explore on your own or join a Holland America excursion.

### Day 11: Rhodes

Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. We will enjoy a walking tour of Lindos, a fortress used by the Greeks and Phoenicians, followed by a visit to the great palace and acropolis of the Grand Masters of Knight. Enjoy lunch on your own and time to shop before returning to the ship for dinner.

### Day 12: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together again for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, enjoy the ship as you spend a day at sea.

### Day 13: Kusadasi (Ephesus)

Today you visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where Paul taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people. See Marble Street and the Library of Celsius. We will see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the site of the scene of religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts.

### Day 14: Athens—Depart for Home or Optional Rome Extension

We will have an early morning arrival at the cruise terminal. We meet our guide and begin our day with a tour of the Acropolis of Athens, the Parthenon and Mars Hill where Paul debated with the Athenian philosophers in Acts 17. Next, we visit the ancient marketplace, or agora, where Paul would have walked and met the citizens of Athens. Lunch will be on your own and time for shopping. Those selecting the Rome extension will head to the airport for an evening flight and overnight in Rome, Italy. Those who did not select the Rome Extension option will transfer to a hotel for an early flight for the U.S.

### Optional Rome Extension

### Day 1: Rome

Welcome to Rome, Italy! After our evening flight from Athens to Rome, we will be transported to our hotel for a good night's rest. Tomorrow we are touring this ancient, beautiful city that was so significant in the history of the church and the world.

### Day 2: Colosseum, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, Mamertine Prison

We will begin our day with a visit to the Colosseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, the center of day-to-day life in ancient Rome. We will also visit the Arch of Titus, built to commemorate the defeat of Israel by the Emperor Titus. We then visit the exterior of the Mamertine Prison, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned. Lunch will be on your own. Enjoy some free time to explore on your own and shop for some keepsakes to remember your trip.

### Day 3: Abby of Three Fountains, Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Palatine Hill & St. Peter's Square

Our day begins in Rome with a visit the Abbey of Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom. Here, we pause for a time of teaching on a life well-lived for the gospel of Jesus Christ. Afterward, we will take a downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps.

Next, we will visit St. Peter's Square for an optional tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, or Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own. Get a good night of rest, we will be flying home in the morning.

We will transfer to the airport in the morning to depart for the U.S. and enjoy the memories of a trip of a lifetime!
