RESERVATIONS

A completed reservation form and a \$500 deposit are due to reserve a place on this tour. Deposits are due at the time of reservation.

PAYMENTS

Second deposit will be due **September 16, 2026**. Final payment will be due **March 31, 2027**. Payment can be made by check, ACH, Visa, or MasterCard (Payment by Credit Card: 3% fee applies) Payments not received on time can result in reservation cancellation without refund. **Additional bookings after the final payment deadline may result in additional administrative fees. FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL Cruise/Tour

September 16-27 or 30, 2027

Day 1: Departure

Flight departing from Washington/ Dulles International Airport (IAD).

Day 2: Arrive in Athens

Upon arriving in Athens, we will take a bus tour of the city from the Athens Airport to our hotel in Corinth. We will stop at the Corinth Canal for some pictures and learn about the history of this famous canal. Breakfast and dinner in Corinth are included at the hotel; lunches are on your own.

Day 3: Corinth & the Celebrity Infinity

We wake up this morning in Corinth! We begin our day with a tour of the ancient biblical city, one of ancient Greece's most important and thriving port cities. Paul spent much time in Corinth, and his story comes to life when you stand at the very place where Paul stood trial for preaching the gospel.

Then we're off to the Athen's port of Piraeus to embark on the *Celebrity Infinity* cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful cruise ship.

Cruise Ship: Celebrity Infinity

Day 4: Kavala (Philippi)

Nestled into the northeastern coast of Greece, the hillside city of Kavala (ancient city of Philippi) overlooks the Aegean Sea and is the main seaport of eastern Macedonia. Philippi was the first European city where Paul preached the Gospel. We will tour the Archeological Site of Philippi along with Saint Lydia's Baptistry and the Monument of Saint Paul. After our tour, enjoy lunch on your own and free time before our coach takes us back to our cruise ship.



Athens

Day 5: Thessaloniki

This morning, our ships arrives in Thessaloniki where the Apostle Paul preached the Gospel and wrote two letters to the Church in Thessalonica to encourage the saints to be prepared for Jesus Christ's return. Today, Thessaloniki is the second largest city in Greece and filled with significant biblical history. During our visit in Thessaloniki we will tour the Archeological Museum of Thessaloniki and the White Tower. Afterwards, we will return to our cruise ship for a delicious dinner and a refreshing night's rest.

Day 6: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together on the ship for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, enjoy the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 7: Rhodes

The island of Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. During our tour, we will visit the archeological site of Lindos. After enjoying lunch on your own, you will have the opportunity to tour the Palace of the Grand Master of the Knights of Rhodes before returning to our cruise ship for the evening.

Day 8: Kusadasi (for Ephesus)

Today we visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where St. Paul preached and taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people, see Marble Street, the Library of Celsius, and the Temple of Hadrian. We will also see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. We will also visit the theater, the site

where the religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts took place. St. Paul founded the Church here and was used of God to bring a major revival.

Day 9: Mykonos

Our next stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos windmills. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own with Celebrity.

Day 10: Santorini

Today we stop at one of the most beautiful islands in the world. It's on the bucket list of many! Explore on your own or join a Celebrity excursion. It is a very accessible city and a beautiful place to explore on your own. The ship does not dock at a port here, instead we will disembark onto "tenders," the small boats from the ship that will take us to the island. Those with limited mobility will need to be extra careful.

Day 11: Day at Sea

We will come together again this morning for a time of worship and teaching from the book of Acts before enjoying another relaxing day at sea.

Day 12: Athens

After a good night's rest, we arrive in Athens, disembark our cruise ship, meet our coach, and begin our day with a tour of the archeological sites of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis, Erechtheum and Parthenon before viewing Athens from Mars Hill where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers.



Corinth

After a full day in Athens, those opting for the Rome extension will head to the airport for an evening flight to Rome, Italy. Those not opting for Rome, will overnight in Athens and be ready for a morning flight home.

Rome, Italy

After our evening flight from Athens to Rome, we will be transported to our hotel for a good night's rest so we will be ready to tour this ancient, beautiful city the next morning.

Day 13: Colosseum, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, Palatine Hill, & the Mamertine Prison

We begin our day with a visit to the Colosseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. The Colosseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Colosseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70. We will then visit the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

Day 14: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abbey of Three Fountains, & St. Peter's Square

We begin our second day in Rome with a visit to the Abbey of Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for his faith and the ancient roads that he walked on. We will then enjoy an amazing downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. After lunch, we will visit St. Peter's Square at the Vatican.



Colosseum

Here you can explore St. Peter's Basilica or book an optional tour of the museum and Sistine Chapel. We will end the day with our farewell dinner. We will fly home the next morning.

Day 15: Depart for Home

This morning, we will transfer to the airport to depart for the U.S. and enjoy the memories of a trip of a lifetime!
