RESERVATIONS

FINAL PAYMENT
Second deposit will be due September 15, 2026. Final payment will be due December 1, 2026. Payments can be made by check, ACH, Visa, or MasterCard (payment by Credit Card: 3% fee applies). Payments not received on time can result in reservation cancellation without refund. *Additional bookings after the final payment deadline may result in additional administrative fees. Fee amounts imposed are at the discretion of Rishon World Tours.

Day 1: Departure

Today, our group embarks on a journey to the Holy Land. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience. Make sure to get some rest on the flight because soon you will be walking where our Savior walked!

Day 2: Arrive in Israel

Welcome to Israel! We arrive in Tel Aviv, where we will meet our guide and travel to our hotel.

Day 3: Joppa, Caesarea, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth

We begin our day traveling at the ancient port of Joppa, where Jonah sailed from to flee from God's command to go to Nineveh, and Peter raised Dorcas to life and later received a vision from the Lord to share the Gospel with the Gentiles. Next, we will travel along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea and view the Roman Amphitheatre, the Hippodrome, and the Aqueduct. We will continue our journey to Mt. Carmel, where the prophet Elijah defeated the priests of Baal. Next, we will journey through the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo, the Armageddon battlefield, and then travel to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus, and tour the Nazareth Village, a wonderful recreation of biblical times. We will end our day with a drive by Cana.



Day 4: Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, & Sea of Galilee Boat Ride

Our day begins with a devotional at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave His inspiring Sermon on the Mount. Next, we tour Capernaum, where Jesus did most of His miracles, and the home of the Apostle Peter. Next, we will enjoy St. Peter's fish for lunch before a relaxing cruise on the Sea of Galilee and reflect on the miracles that confirmed Jesus is God the Son. We will close our day with a special baptism at Yardenit before returning to our hotel for dinner and a good night's rest.

Day 5: Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Mt Arbel, Magdala

After breakfast, we will depart for Tel Dan, where Israel fell into alternative worship, and then drive to Caesarea Philippi, the site of Peter's confession of Jesus Christ. Next, we will journey to Mt. Arbel for a breathtaking view of the Sea of Galilee and a time of worship. Next, we will journey to Magdala, the hometown of Mary Magdalene, where a first-century synagogue and village bring the world of Jesus' Galilee to life, before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 6: Beit She'an, Gideon's Spring, Baptismal Site

Today, we will start the day at Yardenit on the Jordan River, a beautiful location for baptismal reflection. Then we will head to



Beit Shean, a magnificent archeological site, where the Philistines defeated King Saul. Next, we will travel to Gideon's Spring, where God commanded Gideon to select 300 men to battle against the Midianites. At the end of a full day, we will spend a night at the Dead Sea.

Day 7: Masada, Ein Gedi, Qumran, Mt. Scopus

Our day begins at Masada, where we will take a cable car ride to the mountain top fortress of Masada. Here, our guide will share with us the history behind the famous zealots' last stand. Next, we journey to Ein Gedi, "Springs of the Goat," an oasis on the western shore of the Dead Sea. This is the place where David hid from King Saul and where God defeated Israel's enemies while King Jehoshaphat led Israel in praise and worship. Then we will travel to Qumran, the site where the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947. We will finish the day with the beautiful overlook from Mount Scopus, offering sweeping views of Jerusalem.

Day 8: Mt. Zion, Jewish Quarter, Temple Institute, Western Wall, Southern Steps

Our day begins at Mt. Zion to learn about the biblical significance of this location. Then we will travel to the Jewish Quarter of Jerusalem, followed by a visit to the Temple Institute, dedicated to preparing for a future Temple. Next, we will have an opportunity to stand in prayer at the



Western Wall, the last remnant of the Second Temple, and continue beneath the city through the fascinating Western Wall Tunnels, revealing massive stones from Herod's time. If available, ascend the Temple Mount, the most sacred site in Judaism and central to biblical worship. Conclude at the Southern Steps, where Jesus and His disciples would have entered the Temple courts, offering a meaningful connection to Scripture and the footsteps of faith. After a full day of touring, we will return to our hotel for dinner and rest.

Day 9: Israel Museum, Yad Vashem, Abraham's Tent Experience

Today, we begin at the Israel Museum, where the Model of Jerusalem brings the city as it appeared in Jesus' time vividly to life, and the Dead Sea Scrolls offer a profound connection to the earliest preserved biblical texts. Continue our day at Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust memorial, whose name is drawn from Isaiah 56:5 and which soberly remembers the six million Jews who perished, calling visitors to honor the image of God in every person and to stand against hatred and injustice in every generation. The day concludes with experiencing warm Middle Eastern hospitality at Abraham's Tent, recalling God's covenant with Abraham and the faith of the patriarchs. Conclude at the Shepherds' Fields in Bethlehem, where angels announced the birth of Christ, reflecting on the humble setting that witnessed the fulfillment of God's promise to the world.

Day 10: City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, St. Peter in Gallicantu, Shepherd's Fields

Step into the heart of biblical Jerusalem as you explore the City of David, where Scripture comes alive at Jeremiah's Cistern and along the ancient water systems of Hezekiah's Tunnel, culminating at the Pool of Siloam, the site associated with Jesus' miracle of healing the blind man. Continue to St. Peter in Gallicantu, traditionally believed to mark the place of Caiaphas' house, where Jesus was held, and Peter's denial took place. The day concludes at the Shepherd's Fields, recalling the angelic announcement of Christ's birth to the shepherds, offering a meaningful

reflection on God's redemptive story from prophecy to fulfillment.

Day 11: Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Pool of Bethesda, St. Anne's Church, Antonia Fortress, Way of the Cross, Garden Tomb

We have a full day in Jerusalem, which begins with a view of the Holy City from the Mount of Olives, where we will hear a devotional teaching about Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. Then we will walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed to the Father before He was betrayed. Next, we will visit the Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church. Afterward, we will visit the Antonia Fortress, which was built by Herod the Great to honor Mark Antony. It is also believed to be the site where Pontius Pilate sentenced Jesus Christ to be crucified. Then, we will visit the Garden Tomb, where it is believed Jesus Christ was crucified at Golgotha and buried nearby and rose victoriously three days later. There we will worship and partake of communion together. We will close our day with a Farewell Dinner.

No Egypt extension - After a full day in Israel, passengers not traveling to Egypt will stay the night in Jerusalem and will be transported on the morning of April 16, 2027, to the Tel Aviv Airport to depart for the U.S.

Optional Egypt extension - After a full day in Israel, Egypt extension travelers will overnight in Jerusalem, then transfer to the airport on April 16, 2027, for their flight to Cairo, Egypt, arriving for an overnight stay.

Welcome to Egypt!

Egypt - Day 2

Continue to Sakkara and the Imhotep Museum, home to the Step Pyramid and treasures from one of the world's earliest civilizations. In the evening, enjoy a three-hour dinner cruise on the Nile River, reflecting on the river that shaped the land where Moses was drawn from the water and where God displayed His mighty power. Lunch is on your own.

Egypt - Day 3

Stand before the majestic Pyramids of Giza, enduring reminders of the ancient world in which Abraham once journeyed. Visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, where remarkable treasures bring to life the history and culture of biblical Egypt. Those who wish may enjoy an optional camel ride across the desert sands. Lunch is on your own before returning to the hotel for dinner and an evening of rest.
