RESERVATIONS

A completed online reservation form and a \$500 deposit are due to reserve a place on this tour. Check payments can be sent to: 6550 SE Alexander St., Hillsboro, OR 97129

FINAL PAYMENT

Second deposit will be due October 30, 2026. Final payment will be due January 8, 2026. Payments can be made by check, ACH, Visa, or MasterCard (payment by Credit Card: 3% fee applies). Payments not received on time can result in reservation cancellation without refund. *Additional bookings after the final payment deadline may result in additional administrative fees. Fee amounts imposed are at the discretion of Rishon World Tours.

This letter must be presented at airport check-in. All international tours require a current passport. Entrance to Israel requires your passport be valid for 6 months after your return date. FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL

April 21 - May 4, 2027

Day 1: Departure

Overnight flight departing from the international airport near you. (Flight arrangements made on your own or by Rishon Tours.)

Day 2: Arrive in Athens

Arrive at the Athens airport. We will travel from the Athens airport to our hotel for dinner and a relaxing evening. We will take a bus tour of Athens on the way to the hotel.

Day 3: Corinth & the Celebrity Infinity

We wake up this morning in Corinth! We begin with a tour of the ancient biblical city, one of ancient Greece's most important and thriving port cities. Paul spent much time in Corinth, and his story comes to life when you stand at the very place where Paul stood trial for preaching the gospel. Then we're off to the port of Piraeus to embark on the Celebrity Infinity cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful cruise ship.

Day 4: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together for a time of worship and a message from the book of

Acts. Then, enjoy the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 5: Thessaloniki - Berea

This morning our ship docks in Thessaloniki, Greece, where the Apostle Paul preached the Gospel and wrote two letters to the Church there to encourage the saints to be prepared for Jesus Christ's return. Today, Thessaloniki is the second-largest city in Greece and is filled with significant biblical history. Today, we will explore on our own or book an excursion from Celebrity. Spend the day exploring this ancient biblical city or take a few moments to walk the local beaches. The ship will spend the night at the dock in Thessaloniki.

Day 6: Thessaloniki - Berea

We wake up this morning in Thessaloniki! Today we will gather on the dock as a group, meet our guide, and bus to visit the Jewish Synagogue, as was the custom of Paul in the days of his missionary journeys. We will also visit the White Tower of Thessaloniki, a monument and museum on the waterfront of the city. We will also visit the Archeological Museum of Thessaloniki. We will enjoy lunch on our own and have time to explore before our coach returns us to our cruise ship.

Day 7: Kavala (Philippi)

Nestled into the northeastern coast of Greece, the hillside city of Kavala (ancient city of Philippi) overlooks the Aegean Sea and is the main seaport of eastern Macedonia. Philippi was the first European city where Paul preached the Gospel. We gather on the dock early to meet our guide and bus to tour the Archeological Site of Philippi along with Saint Lydia's Baptistry and the Monument of Saint Paul. After our tour, enjoy lunch on your own and free time before our coach takes us back to our cruise ship.

Day 8: Day at Sea

Relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship as you spend a day at sea. We will gather together in our own meeting place for a time of worship and a teaching from the book of Acts. The rest of the day is yours to relax and enjoy the beautiful Celebrity Infinity.

Day 9: Kusadasi (Ephesus)

The ship docks at the port of Kusadasi for our visit to Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor and one of the most important cities of Paul's missionary journeys. Paul's visit there brought a great revival. It is considered one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world.

Day 9: Kusadasi (Ephesus) cont.

We will walk the ancient streets, visit the amazing library of Ephesus, and stop for a time of teaching at the outdoor theater where a riot broke out because of the gospel preached by Paul in the city. Today, lunch is included. We will enjoy an authentic Turkish buffet with so, so many choices! After lunch, we stop to visit the Basilica of St. John and visit the ruins of the temple of ancient Artimis. We will then return to port, where you will have an opportunity to explore the Turkish bazaar next to the cruise ship terminal.

Day 10: Rhodes

The island of Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. During our tour, we will visit the Archeological site of Lindos. After enjoying lunch on your own, you will have the opportunity to tour the Palace of the Grand Master of the Knights of Rhodes before returning to our cruise ship for the evening.

Day 11: Crete

Arrive in Heraklion, Crete, a beautiful Greek island known for its famous archeological sites, stunning beaches, and lively town, which is full of hidden treasures from the Venetian period. Today we enjoy a day to explore on our own or book an excursion with Celebrity. Crete is famous for the Knossos Palace and the Koules Venetian Fortress. You could also visit the Heraklion Archeological Museum and experience the history of one of the oldest civilizations in the world! Explore and enjoy, and then head to the port to embark again on our cruise ship.

Day 12: Corinth

This morning, our ship docks in Athens. We will begin our day with a bus tour to Corinth. We will stop at the Corinth Canal and then continue our journey to the ancient biblical city of Corinth, one of ancient Greece's most important port cities. Paul spent much time in Corinth, and his story comes to life when you stand at the very place where Paul stood trial for preaching the gospel. Lunch on your own at a local restaurant.

After lunch, we will explore the Acropolis of Corinth, where there is a breathtaking view of the ancient city and nearby port. We then return to the ship for dinner and our final evening onboard the Celebrity Infinity.

Day 13: Athens

After a good night's rest, we disembark our cruise ship, meet our coach, and begin our day with a tour of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis before viewing Athens from Mars Hill, where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers. After a full day in Athens, we will head to the airport for our flight back to the US.
